Congratulations to Brian Cook for winning the over 75's and Kylee Hammett for winning the over 55's. Congratulations to all Australians that played in the World championships with some great squash being played over the week.

We had a great turn out for the State titles played at Daisy Hill over the May long weekend with 136 players participating, with players attending from Cairns to NSW. Matches were held Friday, Saturday and Sunday with a dinner held at the Meadowbrook Golf Club where we had fabulous food and a great speaker, Paul Price. Congratulations to Daisy Hill for providing such a fabulous centre and all the staff and volunteers that helped during the weekend. At this tournament we announced the Encouragement Award congratulations to the recipient - Jake Markwart.

I'm pleased to announce next year's State Titles will be held at Maroochydore Squash Centre from Friday night 29 April to Monday 1st May. Due to having 6 courts and with expected large numbers of participates the championships will be played over 3 ½ days. Starting on the Friday night and finishing at



lunchtime on Monday. Please keep this in mind when you are booking flights, matches will be played Monday with presentations after the last match. During the next few months more information will be available as the sub committee has commenced planning.

I had the opportunity to attend the Squash Qld Forum & AGM recently held at Australia Squash Headquarters. It was very interesting, and they had some great speakers. Squash Qld manage squash throughout Queensland

including juniors, tournaments and promoting squash.

QMSA sponsored the Qld Junior Championships held at the Nerang Squash Centre by supplying the scoring tablets that were used for the championships and these will be used in other junior tournaments throughout the year, and we are looking at other avenues to support iuniors.

The last couple of tournaments were well supported with Gympie 68 players, Gladstone 44 players, Alex Hills 69 players, Labrador 68 players, Maroochydore 92 players. The last tournament was held at Toowoomba and had 80 players participating. We also had a junior tournament on the Saturday at Toowoomba and this allowed some parents who had their children playing juniors to participate in the masters' event. The concept was well received and gave both juniors and masters the opportunity to watch and enjoy the vibrancy of a masters and junior events.

Our membership remains very healthy with over 250 members so far this year.

All the best for everyone attending the Australian Masters in Adelaide. It will be great to catch up with our other Aussie squash friends from around the country that we haven't had the opportunity in the last 3 years. QMSA have 72 people attending the championships over the 2 weeks and the teams entries are looking healthy with 48 people playing.

QMSA have 6 players (Kym Tracey-Patte, Melissa Martin, Sue Davis, Sue Williams, Steven Finitis & Jim Mobbs) of the 14 playing for Australian in the Trans Tasman team being played during the Australian Championships. Finally, I would like to take this opportunity thank the outgoing committee and in particular the president, Robyn Prentice for all the work and dedication to masters squash. I wish her well in her new endeavours.

Trans Tasman Series

The Trans Tasman Series is conducted on a biennial basis where the the best Masters squash players from Australia and New Zealand compete for the Vic Belsham Trophy over a series of 3 tests. Each team consists of 7 males and 7 females from the age groups of over 35 to over 65 years of age.

The next Trans Tasman Series will be hosted by Adelaide SA in October 2022. Garry Irwin has been selected as the Australian Trans Tasman Test Team Manager. The Australian team was announced on 8 April 2022 and is as follows:

Replacement - due to personal reasons, Jason Mudge had to withdraw from the team. His replacement is Glenn Hitch (WA). This is a milestone for Trans Tasman Test history as Glenn and his wife Johannah now become the first husband and wife to represent either country.

With a blend of (10) seasoned representatives and (4) on debut (Steve, Shahroze, Peter and Joannah), this team will prove a mighty challenge to the New Zealand team when it is announced.

Brief History of the Trans Tasman Series

After the success of two unofficial tours by Australian Masters players to NZ in 1982 and 1983, a meeting, under the Chairmanship of the Australian Squash Rackets Association (ASRA) President, Mr Vic Belsham, was held in Brisbane on 28 April 1984 between the ASRA Executive and representatives of the New Zealand Squash Rackets Association (NZSRA) with the object of the meeting being to rationalise the program of events between the two countries going forward. An item on the Agenda was the question of an official Masters Teams Series between the two countries. It was agreed that the inaugural official Teams Series would commence with a visit by New Zealand to Australia in Sept 1984. The Series was conducted on the Gold Coast during the Australian Individual Championships at Southport.

The Trans Tasman Series was conducted on an annual basis (1984 to 1993). Apart from some slight variations in the calendar between 1995 and 2000 due to World Championships. The Trans Tasman Series has been conducted on a Biennial basis since 2001.

There have been (24) Trans Tasman Series conducted since 1984 with Australia winning 20 and NZ 4.


